Intro and Opportunity classes are exempt from USEF and USDF membership requirements.

BLM - Qualifying class for 2010 BLMs. Riders must be members of a participating organization at the time of the show to be eligible.

GAIG - Qualifying class for the 2010 GAIG/USDF Championships (declare qualifying ride on entry form) – Entry fee plus additional \$10 fee required, **MUST BE PAID PRIOR TO THE START OF THE CLASS.** Rider and owner must be USDF participating members and USEF members; horse must be USDF Lifetime registered and USEF recorded. Owners may be USDF Business Members. Except for FEI Junior or Young Rider Freestyle

entries, competitors in freestyle qualifying classes must submit a photocopy of a test verifying eligibility to enter class.

JR - Open to Junior riders only; ages 18 and under in the current year.

* **TOC** - Test of Choice (specify test level on entry form). May ride any test that does not have a specific class. May be qualifier if proper test ridden and fees paid.

+ – USDF Musical Freestyle only; no Pas de Deux or Quadrille.

PRIZE LIST DIRECTIVES

EVERY CLASS OFFERED HEREIN WHICH IS COVERED BY THE RULES AND SPECIFICATIONS OF THE CURRENT USEF RULE BOOK AND WILL BE CONDUCTED AND JUDGED IN ACCORDANCE THEREWITH.

SHOW AWARDS:

- USDF/Dover Adult Amateur Medal: Awarded from Class 19, Second Level Test 3
- Trophy and 6 ribbons in each class.
- High Score. Trophy and High Score and Reserve High Score ribbons awarded in the following categories: Each USEF Level*, FEI Levels*, USDF Freestyle, FEI Freestyle, SVDA Member*, Senior Rider*, Junior Rider*, Adult Amateur*. Unclaimed ribbons and trophies will NOT be mailed. *Intro, Opportunity and MFS scores excluded.

SVDA SERIES AWARDS:

- To recognize achievement for competitors that compete at both shows and sustain a high level of performance.
- Who: horse/rider combination that competes at a given level in each licensed show. Must have at least one score from each show.
- Entries: Prior to start of show; identify the horse rider combination that will be participating by indicating on entry blank or signing up in show office.
- How to Win: Highest score based on the average of the highest 2 scores from both shows.
- Tracking: Current standings will be posted on SVDA website.
- Awards: Champion and Reserve for each category: USEF Training through First Level (excludes MFS, Opportunity); USEF Second through Fourth Level (excludes MFS); FEI Levels (excludes MFS, Young Horse, Para-Equestrian).

ENTRIES:

- Completed Entries with full payment are to be mailed to the Show Secretary and must be **RECIEVED** by the closing date. Entries without full payment will be placed on wait list until payment is received.
- Post entries are taken on a first come, first served basis to fill scratches. With paid **\$25.00** late fee.
- Entries received after the show is full will be returned or placed on a waiting list.
- All entries must be typed or printed on a Region One 2010 entry form and include:
- Three Original Handwritten Signatures: Owner, Rider, Trainer, and Coach (if applicable);
- Photocopy of NEGATIVE Coggins test (through last day of show). The date, accession #, and owner's name and address **MUST BE LEGIBLE**. **Coggins must come with entry or the entry will not be processed**
- Proof of USEF/USDF membership must be included with entry form. If proof of membership is not provided, non-member fees will be charged. Please provide the Master Verification from USEF & USDF (www.eqverification.org) although membership cards or photocopies of cards are still acceptable.
- Management reserves the right to cancel classes inadequately filled, combine classes, and to make other necessary changes. Management reserves the right to add or substitute judges.
- Check or money order made payable to "SVDA, Inc." and mailed with the completed entry to SHOW SECRETARY. **ALL RETURNED CHECKS ARE SUBJECT TO CURENT BANK CHARGES.**
- Show Office Hours: Saturday 2pm – 4pm, Sunday – 6:30am to 1 hour after show ends.

REFUNDS: No refunds after closing date for any reason, including cancellation due to inclement weather, Acts of God, other emergencies and/or terrorism. Until closing date, refunds on entries minus \$20 office fee.

TIMES: Times will be posted on website, www.gosvda.org. No times will be mailed.

STABLING:

- Limited: Permanent stalls with doors. No stallions allowed in the barn. (No stabling will be offered). Initial bedding provided. Stalls must be paid with entry fees. \$45 night \$40 day. Must list an emergency contact on the stabling portion of entry form. NO ELECTRIC FOR TRAILERS.

FOOTING:

- Competition: Two 20m x 60m sand arenas
- Warm-up: Sand warm-up, grass fields, and covered arena

DIRECTIONS:

From the East: Take I64 West to Exit 242A (Rt. 199W). Go 5.3 miles & turn left onto Jamestown Rd. (Rt. 31). Go 3.2 miles & turn right onto 4H Club Rd. (Rt. 680). Go ½ mile to stop sign & turn right onto Greenspings Rd. (Rt. 614). Farm is on the left.

From the West: Take I64 East to Exit 234 (Lightfoot/Rt. 199). Right onto Rt. 199. Take the Monticello Rd. Exit, bare right going immediately thru two traffic lights & continue on to third traffic light. Make left onto 614 Centerville Rd. Continue to RT 5. Turn right & then immediate left onto Greenspings Rd. (Rt. 614). Farm is approx. 2 miles on Right.

OTHER:

- **PROPER HEADGEAR MUST BE WORN AT ALL TIMES WHILE ON HORSEBACK.**
- **ALL DOGS MUST BE ON A LEASH AT ALL TIMES.**
- **Pre-Show Schooling:** Anyone wishing to school before 2pm on Saturday must check in with the Carleton Farms office, pay a schooling fee, provide current coggins and sign a liability waiver.
- The phone number for the Veterinarian on Call will be posted in each barn and the show office.
- Food concession will be available during show hours.
- If ponies are entered and in need of measurement card, an appointment for measuring **MUST** be made with show management prior to the show.
- **HOLD HARMLESS CLAUSE:** The Equine Activity Liability laws of the State of Virginia, VA Code Ann. Sec 3.2-6200-6203 state among its statutory provisions that , “NOTICE: Intrinsic dangers in equine activity, include (i) the propensity of equines to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm, or death to persons on or around them; (ii) the unpredictability of an equine’s reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement, and unfamiliar objects, persons, or other animals; (iii) certain hazards such as surface and subsurface conditions; (iv) collisions with other animals or objects; and (v) the potential of a participant acting in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to the participant or others, such as failing to maintain control over the equine or not acting within the participant’s ability.” No Participant nor any participant’s parent, guardian, or representative shall have or make any claim against or recover from any equine activity sponsor, equine professional, or any other person for injury, loss, damage, or death of the participant resulting from any of the intrinsic dangers of equine activities. It is further understood that each owner, rider, spectator, and other participants assume any and all risks of loss or injury and agrees to hold harmless, regardless of negligent acts or omissions SVDA, Inc., Carlton Farms, USDF, USEF, its instructors, officers, directors, agents, show management, show committee, and all other horse show personnel.

ADDITIONAL USEF AND USDF REQUIREMENTS:

- Each barn has one sharps container per 50 horses available. Competition Management may fine any individual including trainers, owners, exhibitors, or their agents up to \$100 for improper disposal of needles or other sharp disposable instruments.

- Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. Violations of this rule will be cause for sanctions against the parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) who are responsible for the child committing the offense. Penalties may include exclusion of the child, parent(s), guardian(s), and/or trainer(s) from the competition grounds for the remainder of the competition and charges being filed against any of the above individuals in accordance with Chapter 6. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule.
- **USEF MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT**
Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Preliminary Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$30 nonmember registration fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Requirements of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions; 8) Opportunity classes. 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes.
- **ATTENTION COMPETITORS:** Each competitor is responsible for supplying management with correct association numbers (USDF, United States Equestrian Federation) for horse, owner, rider, and trainer, before the day(s) of the competition. The scores of competitors who fail to supply correct numbers may not be counted toward national awards.
